

South Bend Sod Busters Camping Rules

Do your part to make sure everyone has a safe and enjoyable camping experience.

Amenities: Camper is responsible to provide his/her own water and electric.

Gate Hours: Gate closes from 12 a.m. to 7 a.m. for the safety and security of our campers.

Quiet Hours: are from 11 p.m. until 6 a.m. At night, voices carry so moderation is essential.

Pets: Campers are responsible for their pets at all times. Pets must be on a leash 6 feet or less, in length at all times when on Sod Busters property. If pet becomes a nuisance and potentially harmful to other guests, pet will be requested to be removed from property immediately.

Vehicles: Must be shut down during quiet hours except for moving to and from entrance and exit.

Alcohol: Possession of alcohol by persons under the age of 21 is against the law in Indiana; and this will be enforced.

Fires and Firewood: Fires are permitted and must be completely extinguished prior to leaving campsite and must remain at a reasonable size.

Clean up: Campers are responsible to clean up all trash and place in barrels before departing.
